The New Mexico Jewish Historical Society's 18th Annual Conference focuses on the conflicting themes of war and peace. While many of New Mexico's Jews eagerly responded to their country's call to service in the armed forces, others deeply opposed the role of the United States in foreign military adventures and played leadership roles in the peace movement of the 1960s and 1970s. The Conference will feature papers presented by historians, as well as panel discussions by military veterans and participants in the anti-Vietnam War peace demonstrations.

The keynote speaker at Saturday evening's banquet will be Mark Kurlansky, author of *A Basque History of the World*, *History of Salt* and most recently, *1968*, which documented the social upheavals all over the world that occurred that year. Mr. Kurlansky will address the provocative topic, "Jews in 1968 and Today: What's Going Wrong?"
